# COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES:

This course will introduce the most common computer hardware and software related concepts and terminology, thus providing the students with the necessary knowledge and understanding of the role of microcomputers in problem solving in business. The students will be familiarized with the basic characteristics and features of PCs and how they relate to optimal computer performance to meet specific business requirements.

Application software covered in this course will include Microsoft Word 97, Microsoft Excel 97, and Microsoft Power Point 97. Students will be expected to gain and demonstrate working knowledge in the above applications. In addition, a brief coverage of the Internet Explorer and how to use it to access the World Wide Web will be provided.
