**COURSE DESCRIPTION
AND OBJECTIVES:**

This course will introduce the most common computer hardware and software related concepts and terminology, thus providing the students with the necessary knowledge and understanding of the role of microcomputers in problem solving in business. The students will be familiarized with the basic characteristics and features of PCs and how they relate to optimal computer performance to meet specific business requirements.

System software covered in this course will consist of *Windows 98*; application software will include *Microsoft Word 2000*, *Microsoft Excel 2000*, and *Microsoft Power Point 2000*. Students will be expected to gain and demonstrate working knowledge in the above applications. In addition, a brief coverage of the basics of the World Wide Web and its accessing will be provided.
